

# KomiKon Shadow File - Nintendo's Cultural Trial

## Problem Statement

Japan, through Nintendo, has acted as a silent courier of cultural appropriation-lifting significant figures, structures, and symbols from other civilizations (especially China and the Soviet Union), and repackaging them for global consumption.
